### *AHRI's Virtual Leadership Forum*

This past November, The Air-Conditioning, Heating, and Refrigeration Institute (AHRI) held its first virtual leadership forum with over 300 participants. Highlights from those sessions are summarized below.

During Covid-19, AHRI has been working hard to further its initiatives and advance the organization's progress. Around the globe, AHRI has promoted the essential nature of our businesses, helping us to remain operational so we can deliver the parts and products our customers need. It has also brought global attention to our expertise with indoor air quality. In addition, AHRI maintained its focus on advocating for members' advancement in our industries. AHRI continues to staff critical positions and has adapted to the pandemic by implementing virtual testing, allowing for 90% of scheduled testing to be completed by the end of the year.

AHRI is seeks to become the globally recognized certification authority. As AHRI creates global standards, both members and new products can benefit from consistency across jurisdictions and fewer constraints imposed by a patchwork of varying local and regional approvals. Examples of new and recently updated ANSI/AHRI standards include 1330 – Performance Rating for Radiant Output of Gas Fired Infrared Heaters, and 1400 – Performance of Indirect Water Heaters. Research also continues for critical industry activities, such as an assessment of Hydrogen Enriched Natural Gas.

AHRI also discussed expansion of its CEO dashboard. In 2021 they plan to launch a new portal for member companies that provides more data analytics and an in-depth view of member product ratings. It also discussed a new online opportunity for member companies to submit their opinions on agency approvals and regulations directly to AHRI. This process will create a more direct link between member input and AHRI advocacy at state and federal levels.
