



Looking forward to A2L

It is now widely known that A2L refrigerants are mildly flammable, thus creating the need for new safety precautions. For years, Fenwal Controls and UTEC have monitored gas ignition and safely switched off gas appliances in the event of a flame failure.

Now, we are excited to offer OEMs an R-454B sensor that are designed to safely shutdown your cooling systems in the event a leak is detected.



Our new sensors communicate utilizing Modbus to interface with your appliance and operate at ranges from -20°F to 200°F. They have the option to self-calibrate or can be manually calibrated; they include self-test capabilities, an end-of-life indicator, and are designed to last 15 years. Designed to meet UL 60335-2-40 Annex LL, these may be the right sensor for your application.
